We are moving into a very busy season in the life of Tuckston United Methodist Church. The coming weeks are filled with activities and events that are noteworthy and are occasions which you do not want to miss.

I am excited about the sermon that I will present on May 5th. The message will be entitled "The Answer to Fear." We live in a fearful age. Columnist Molly Ball wrote the following in an article in "The Atlantic" magazine, "Fear is in the air, and fear is surging. Americans are more afraid to-day than they have been in a long time." What is the Christian response to our propensity to fear? We will discuss this on the first Sunday of the month, as we also observe Holy Communion.

The following Sunday, May 12, is of course Mother's Day. Mother's Day was actually brought to life out of Methodism. A lady by the name of Anna Jarvis inspired the first celebration of Mother's Day at the then Methodist-Episcopal Church in Grafton, West Virginia in 1907. In 1912, the Methodist-Episcopal Church recognized the event and in 1916 President Woodrow Wilson made it an official national celebration. Today, realizing the sensitivity of the day, we observe this day in the United Methodist Church as the Festival of the Christian Home. Our sermon that day will be entitled "Your Family is Larger than You Think," with it based on Mark 3:31-35.

On May 19, I will be hosting a special time from 10:00-10:30 called "Coffee With the Pastor" in the Fellowship Hall. This will be an opportunity for those who have been visiting Tuckston over the past few months to ask questions, and hopefully get answers, about Tuckston and all that we do in mission and ministry in our community and world. Of course, those who are already members of Tuckston are welcome, as well, if there are any questions one may have.

May 19 is also Pentecost Sunday. Pentecost is observed as the "Birthday of the Church." It is on this day that we will remember how the Holy Spirit brought the church to life in a powerful way. Red is the traditional color for Pentecost Sunday so everyone is urged to wear red on that Sunday.

Vacation Bible School is a very important annual event at Tuckston and will be held June 2-6 in the evening. Children may be registered at our web site, www.Tuckston.org, and you may volunteer through our church office. I look forward to seeing you at many of these opportunities in the coming weeks.




